



PROOF OF CITIZENSHIP DOCUMENTATION

You will be traveling outside of the United States. Please note that the name that appears on all of your travel documents must exactly match your name as it appears on your proof of citizenship. Failure to do so may result in denied boarding.

The following information is based on U.S. passport holders.

1. The proof of citizenship you are required to present at airport check-in, the point of entry, and customs and immigration clearance are:
 - _____ An original certified birth certificate from the Department of Vital Statistics (usually requiring a raised seal).
 - _____ Government issued photo identification
 - _____ A U.S. passport with an expiration date at least one year past your return date.
 - _____ Visas for the following countries: _____

2. For entry into Mexico with minors (17 years of age younger) traveling with one parent, you must have a notarized letter of consent from the other natural parent to take the child out of the country, regardless of the status of your marriage.

The following information is based on non U.S. passport holders.

1. If you do not hold a U.S. passport please advise your travel counselor immediately in order to obtain the most recent documentation requirements based on your country of citizenship.

2. If you are stateless, please advise your travel counselor immediately in order to obtain information about the type of documentation required for entry and re-entry.

Failure to produce the correct citizenship documentation can result in, but not limited to:

- Denied boarding
- Non entry at Customs and Immigrations clearance
- Additional expenses
- Failure to travel on requested dates
